To the Citizens of Bridger:

The Bridger Study Commission elected by the voters on November 8, 1994, or thereafter appointed, present this final report to the citizens of this town.

In the conduct of their review the study commission has sought advice and information from people in the community. Opinions and recommendations were solicited from local government officials and citizens. All meetings of the study commission were open to the public. Public hearings were held to determine citizen opinion.

As a result of its' review, the Bridger Local Government Study Commission has concluded that there is general consensus that the existing charter form of government has served this town well since its adoption in 1976, and will continue to do so in the future. We therefore recommend no change in this form of government.
