The City of Ronan Local Government Study Commission elected by the voters on November 8, 1994 or thereafter appointed present this final report to the citizens of this city.


The purpose of the study commission, as defined in state law, is "to study the existing form and powers of our city government and procedures for delivery of local government services and compare them with other forms available under the laws of the state". If some change is deemed necessary, the study commission may submit such proposed change to the electors.

In the conduct of their review the study commission has studied various forms and plans of city government. All meetings of the study commission were open to the public. Public hearings were held to determine citizen opinion.




